

2024 STATIONERY LIST - GRADE 4

During your child's Junior Primary years, all books were sent to School uncovered. From Grade 4 onwards, it is the responsibility of the parents to cover and label all the books.

**** All books must be covered and be brought to School by the **FIRST** day of School, as we already start working on the first day.

Please remember that from now on your child will go to different teachers for different subjects. It is the pupil's responsibility to have the correct book and stationery for every subject.

- Books may be covered in any paper - brown or coloured.
- All books must be labelled correctly - look at the example below for the correct labelling of each book.
- All books must be covered in plastic - slip-on covers are acceptable, but must be taped, at least once, at the back.
- Flip File => **DO NOT COVER** - Just slip a loose piece of paper with your child's name on, into the front pocket. *Please do not glue a name label on!*
- Check that the label is on the front of the book and that the book has not been covered **upside-down**.
- On the first day of School, please do not send your child to School **WITHOUT** books or stationery!
